Why We Are Meeting:

Recent meetings held by EdgeConneX data center developers were touted as “town halls” but they were sales pitches that left questions unanswered.

EdgeConneX is building a massive data center facility (6752 FM 535 at Wolf Lane and FM 535), in Cedar Creek, next to the Stoney Point neighborhood’s 100 families. A new residential development is next door. This project is just one of many data centers targeting Bastrop County using tax incentives (public money). EdgeConneX was granted tax incentives in 2024.

The Political Stakes:

While the Governor has begun taking action, the Texas Legislature left the door open for AI data center abuse by taking little action during the 2023 and 2025 sessions. Only the Governor can call a Special Session.

Our Goals:

We will discuss ideas to present to officials by informed citizens working together.
