

## Join one of 6 ways to make our HOMEGROWN PETITION DRIVE a success!

We at the SAWS Act PAC have designed a homegrown petition drive. This is a way for volunteers to do what has, unfortunately, gone by the wayside of most campaigns for voter approval. They are, almost solely, conducted by paid organizers.

A homegrown campaign is done primarily by volunteers. This can be challenging, especially given the other challenge going on right now – COVID-19. Therefore, we have taken our safety into heightened consideration by providing face shields donated by our local coordinator, ReINETTE King. We will also run through the basics of how to stay safe. And, the good news is we will be outdoors. ☺

Below are the “homegrown teams” working to get the 20,000 signatures to place the SAWS Act on the ballot for May 2021. Petitions are due by the end of 2020. Join one or more teams. We especially need volunteers to help at the early and election day polls, “Number 7” below. We call this the BIG PUSH! Or, simply print, sign and mail the petition on home page or on our “Petition” page at **SAWSAct.org**.

1) **Central Team:** Petitioners are already working at public locations such as parks, running trails and any public sidewalks with foot traffic. But, be careful to go to areas with local people, as only San Antonio voters may sign. Or, you can ask a local store manager to allow you to ask folks to sign the petition as they exit their store.

2) **Delivery and Drop Off Team in all 10 City Council Districts:** We need volunteers in each of the 10 City Council districts who can receive signed petitions (placing a rain proof box outside your door) or to go out to those who request a petitioner to visit them – outside – their home.

3) **Social Media.** Like our Facebook page at SAWS Act PAC. Then, invite your friends to like the page. Get ready to share our posts with your Facebook friends throughout the campaign.

4) **Regular Mail:** We want to prepare for large numbers of requests. Can you be on standby to help get petitions mailed to those who request them? We will provide the materials and stamps.

5) **Faith Team:** Are you active in a local church or are you a local pastor? We invite your participation with this team!

6) **The BIG PUSH!!!** Campaign volunteers are allowed to be 100 feet from the entrance to poll sites. There will be 400,000 or more San Antonio voters voting in this Presidential Election. Early voting is Oct. 13-30. Election Day is Tuesday, November 3. We will be doing a big social media push to ask folks to deliver their signed petitions or to sign one at our tables conveniently located outside poll sites. We need **LOTS of volunteers for the BIG PUSH!**
